## Day Camp LIT Program

- Ideal leadership experience for young people from the communities immediately around Canterbury Hills
- Daily duties run weekly Monday to Friday, from 8:15am to 6pm, with an overnight on Thursday
- Minimum age requirement: 15 years old by Dec. 31, 2010

## Residential LIT I & II Program

- Full Summer Residential LIT Program is highlighted by an Adventure Experience that is planned by the group of LITs. The adventure may take a variety of forms, but it is intended to be a significant challenge that will incorporate all the skills learned throughout the summer
- Half Summer LITs will not participate in the Adventure Experience
- Minimum age requirement  
LIT I: 15 years old by Dec. 31, 2010  
LIT II: 16 years old by Dec. 31, 2010

- You may apply without previously having been a camper or an LIT
- Being an LIT is excellent preparation for a position as a Day Camp Leader, Residential Cabin Leader, or school, parish & community leadership
- The residential LIT program has been designed as a two-summer experience for the full development of leadership skills
